There are 14 universities in the UK and Republic of Ireland offering a full time Bachelor of Science Honours degree in Podiatry / Podiatric Medicine in the UK. The course takes 3 or 4 years to complete depending on where you choose to study. To qualify & practice as a podiatrist you are required to pass all of the courses. This involves clinical work with patients, both in academic & placement environment.

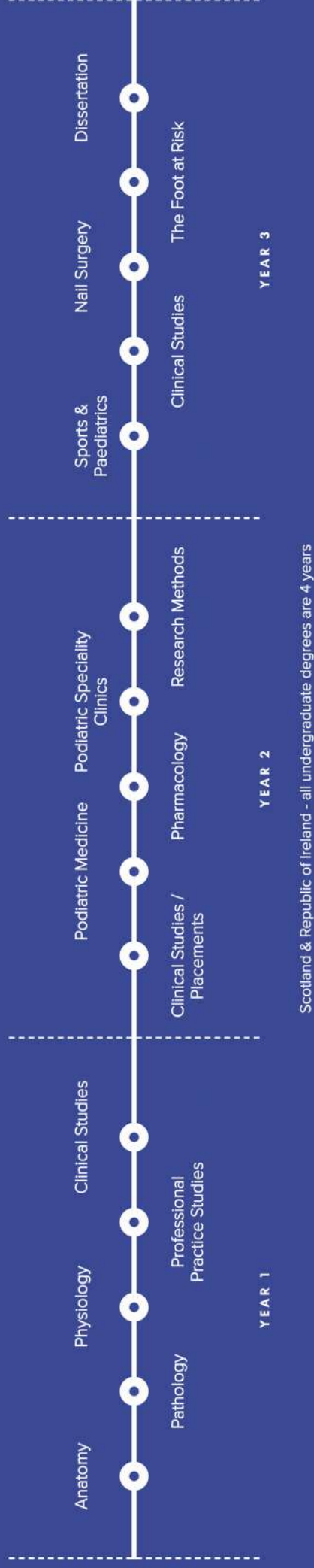
